Lake Vermilion – Soudan Underground Mine State Park Camper Cabins

The park has eight camper cabins. All have electricity and electric heat, but no indoor plumbing. The cabins share a heated restroom/shower building that is available year-round. It has a drinking water fill station for containers that are one gallon or smaller, but there is NO sink for kitchen prep or dishwashing.

Each cabin has a picnic table, deck/porch, full-sized sofa sleeper, table and chairs, bench, floor lamp, and counter space, as well as its own outdoor counter with a nearby electric outlet and fire ring with grill for cooking.

- Ziigwan, Niibin, Dagwaagin, and Biboon cabins have one full-sized mattress below and two fullsized mattresses above.
- Waabanong, Giiwedinong, Zhaawanong, and Ningaabi'anong cabins have two full-sized mattresses below and two twin mattresses on the top bunks.
- Zhaawanong and Niibin cabins are accessible.
- No additional sleeping shelters are allowed.
- Parking is very limited. ATVs and snowmobiles must be trailered in and out to a trailhead.
- Campfires require a daily permit; fee includes firewood.
- Free high-speed wireless (WIFI) connectivity.
