Create an Account - First Time Users

The very first time you want to use the loon volunteer lake management system, you must create an **account**. After that, you'll just need to sign in with your email address and password.

To create an account, enter your email address under the Create Account box and click the blue Create an account button



When you click **Create an account**, you will be directed to one of four potential screens. Below is an overview of the four potential screens followed by detailed instructions of each.

- Screen 1. If the system recognizes your email address because we have it on file as an existing Minnesota Loon Monitoring Program volunteer, you will be directed to an Email Address Verification page. Note that this does NOT mean that you already have a Loon Volunteer Lake Management System account – it just means that we already have programmed your contact information into the system. You must follow all on-screen instructions to finish setting up your account. <u>Refer to pages 2-5</u>.
- Screen 2. If the system does not recognize your email address, you will be directed to the **Create an** Account page. <u>Refer to pages 5-7</u>.
- Screen 3. If the system recognizes your email address because you previously applied for some other DNR account (e.g., burning permit) or because you are using a DNR email address to sign up as a new Loon Monitoring Volunteer, you will be directed to a **modified Create an Account page**. The difference is in the messaging about the password you must use. <u>Refer to pages 8-10</u>.
- Screen 4. If the system recognizes your email address because you already have created a Loon Volunteer Lake Management System account and password, you will be directed to sign in. If you don't remember your password, click the Reset Password link at the bottom of the Sign In page. <u>Refer to pages 10-11</u>.

Screen 1. Email Recognized, but Need to Set Up Loon Volunteer Lake Management System Account

a) If your email address is recognized, you will be directed to an **Email Address Verification page**. Enter a password for your account (twice) and click **Create an account**.

You must click on the link contained in the email message within 24 hours to complete the account sign-up process.

c) The email will come from <u>no-reply@state.mn.us</u> with a subject line of [MNDNR Account Services] Activate your new account. **Click on the blue link within the email** message.

b) This message informs you that you must use the same password that you used when you set up your other DNR account. A verification email will be sent to you to confirm that you have access to the email account. You must click on the link contained in the email message within 24

hours to complete the account sign-up process. If you are a DNR employee using your state email address, you must use your network password for your account password.

If you cannot remember your password:

- i. Click on the link within the message that says "<u>click here to reset your password</u>" (this method cannot be used by DNR employees). You will be directed to a **Reset Password** page. Note that this will open in a separate window in your browser.
- ii. Follow the onscreen instructions.
- iii. Once your password has been reset, you must return to the Create An Account page and finish entering all of your contact information along with your new password. If that page is no longer open, go to <u>https://apps.dnr.state.mn.us/loon/public</u>, enter your email address, and click the Create an account button.
