47-year-old male died when he lost control of the ATV he was operating on a steep embankment in Nokay Lake Township. There was a 21-year-old male passenger who is being treated for injuries.

89-year-old male died when the ATV he was operating went off the road, down an embankment and struck several trees.






National and MN Statistics on ATV-Related Deaths & Injuries




Consumer Product Safety Commission Fatal Accident Data






Consumer Product Safety Commission ER Treatment Data
