2/25/12 – 6:28 a.m. – St. Louis County

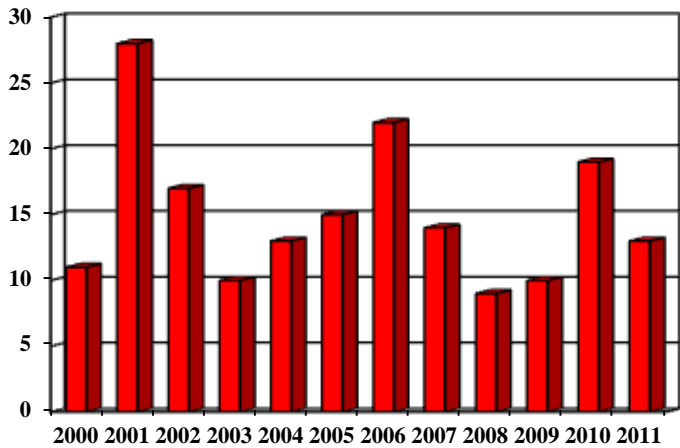
45-year-old male died from severe head trauma when his snowmobile hit a tree next to the Bill Morgan Trail.

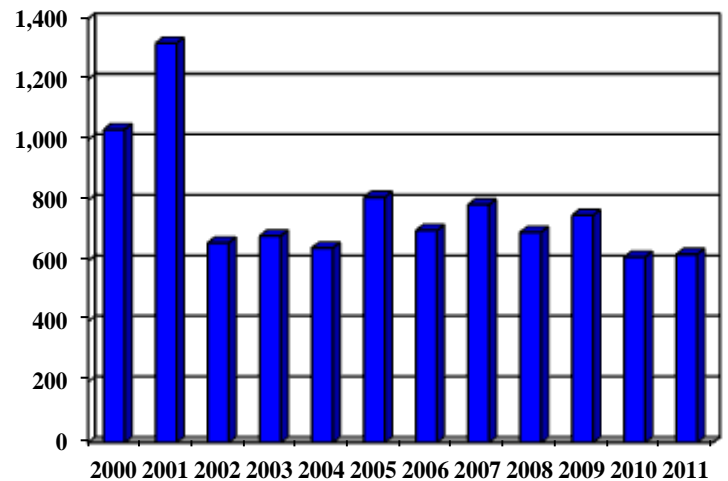
A 19-year-old male and a 20-year-old male drowned after their snowmobile drove into open water.
