



# **Site-Specific Crossing and Restoration Plans**



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## **RESTORATION PREPARATION**

- 1. ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF DECOMPACTION OF THE HARD PACKED SOIL MAY BE UTILIZED IF THERE IS THE POTENTIAL FOR DAMAGE TO EXISTING ROOT STRUCTURE.
- 2. RIPPING OF ENTIRETY OF TEMPORARY ACCESS/WORK AREAS USING A BULLDOZER EQUIPPED WITH A DOWN PRESSURE POWERED RIPPER AND BLADE CAPABLE OF RIPPING A MINIMUM OF 8 INCHES OF HARD PACKED SOIL. BULLDOZER MUST ALSO BE EQUIPPED WITH LOW GROUND PRESSURE TRACKS. ACTIVITIES WILL INCLUDE SITE PREPARATION/SOIL AERATION FOR PLANTING TREES IN AREAS WHERE WOODY VEGETATION HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN REMOVED FOR ACCESS PURPOSES. AND ARE OUTSIDE THE PROPOSED ACCESS ROAD FOOTPRINT.
- 3. DISTANCE BETWEEN RIPPED FURROWS SHOULD NOT EXCEED 2 FEET.
- 4. AR598 WILL BE MAINTAINED BY ENBRIDGE FOR PERMANENT ACCESS TO THE OPERATIONAL RIGHT-OF-WAY AND WILL NOT BE DECOMPACTED/RE-PLANTED.

### MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:

- 5. WORK CANNOT BEGIN BEFORE THE GROUND HAS SUFFICIENTLY THAWED FOR SUFFICIENT RIPPING DEPTH AND SOIL RE-CONTOURING.
- 6. RIPPING DEPTH WILL BE MEASURED UPON INSPECTION. THIS MINIMUM DEPTH MUST BE UNIFORMLY REACHED IN ORDER TO MEET THE TERMS OF THE RESTORATION.

### REQUIRED EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS:

7. BULL DOZER EQUIPPED WITH DOWN PRESSURE POWERED RIPPER AND BLADE CAPABLE OF RIPPING HARD PACKED SOIL TO A MINIMUM DEPTH OF 8 INCHES. MACHINE MUST HAVE SUFFICIENT HORSEPOWER TO PULL A RIPPER THROUGH HIGHLY COMPACTED SOILS.

### SEEDING GUIDELINES:

PLANTING PLAN WITHIN THE VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PUBLIC LANDS AND WATERS.

## **REPLANTING GUIDELINES**

- 1. FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION. ALL WOODY RE-VEGETATION PLANTING WILL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE POST CONSTRUCTION VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PUBLIC LANDS AND WATERS. ALSO SEE THE SITE-SPECIFIC RESTORATION PLAN FOR THE UNNAMED STREAM WITHIN THE LICENSE TO CROSS PUBLIC WATERS APPLICATION.
- 2. ALL TEMPORARY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY WORK SPACE FROM THIS AND PREVIOUS PIPELINE INSTALLATIONS NOT CURRENTLY IN FORESTED CONDITION MUST BE PLANTED WITH A MIX OF THE FOLLOWING SPECIES:
- WHITE PINE
- RED OAK
- SILVER MAPLE
- SUGAR MAPLE
- YELLOW BIRCH (FOCUS PLANTING IN WETTER AREAS)
- 3. NO ONE SPECIES CAN COMPRISE MORE THAN 25% OF PLANTINGS. ALL TREES LISTED ABOVE MUST COMPRISE A MINIMUM OF 10% BY NUMBER PLANTED.
- 4. TREES CAN BE BARE ROOT (MINIMUM OF 12 INCHES IN HEIGHT), OR LARGER POTTED STOCK.
- 5. EFFORT MUST BE MADE TO REDUCE SOIL COMPACTION PRIOR TO PLANTING.
- 6. RED OAK MUST HAVE PROTECTIVE 30" PROTEX PRO/GRO SOLID TUBE TREE PROTECTORS.
- 7. WHITE PINE MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY FENCED WITH WELDED WIRE 2X4 INCH MESH 6 FOOT HIGH FENCING, WITH A 7 FT CIRCUMFERENCE SUPPORTED BY 2 FENCE POSTS.
- 8. TREES SHOULD BE PLANTED RANDOMLY (NOT IN EVEN ROWS) WITH APPROXIMATELY 8 TO 10 FT SPACING FROM SURROUNDING TREES. SPECIES SHOULD ALSO BE RANDOMLY MIXED TOGETHER. WITH THE EXCEPTION OF YELLOW BIRCH WHICH SHOULD BE PLANTED IN WETTER SOILS ONLY.
- 9. TREES MUST BE OF MINNESOTA ORIGIN AND PURCHASED THROUGH MDNR APPROVED NURSERY.
- TO, ENDINEDE MILE MONTY MITTERIENT TO DEPATH A TILES EVOLTED WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION WORKSPACE. ENBRIDGE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ACQUIRING AND PLANTING TREES OF EQUIVALENT SIZE AND SPECIES WITHIN THE RESTORED TEMPORARY WORKSPACE DURING FINAL RESTORATION. DEPENDING ON TIMING, THIS COULD REQUIRE A TEMPORARY BRIDGE OVER THE UNNAMED STREAM.
