

Minnesota Department of Natural Resources Adult Learn to Hunt Deer - 2022

WHO IS ELGIBLE?

Adults (18 or older) NEW to deer hunting. NEW means you have not hunted deer or have only ever hunted deer once in your lifetime. If you have questions about your availability, please contact us and talk about your experiences. Class lectures will be online recordings with in-class time devoted to hands-on application of lecture content. **Participants are expected to watch all videos before coming to class and complete firearms safety training prior to hunting.**

CONTENT WE WILL COVER AND ACTIVITIES PROVIDED

- The role of hunting in deer management, and conservation
- Whitetail deer biology, ecology, and habitat
- Licensing requirements and purchasing
- Using online tools to scout and pick a location
- Conservation organizations and the social support for hunters
- Safe firearms handling, sighting-in firearms, and shooting practice

- Deer hunting equipment and clothing
- How to put together a survival kit
- Tree stand safety and placement
- Scouting and reading deer sign
- Deer butchering & processing
- Application of learned skills and knowledge under the supervision of a mentor while deer hunting, making a safe and ethical shot, field dressing, and camp cooking

COST \$150.00 includes:

All instruction and refreshments at sessions, shooting range fees, and lodging for hunts. Students will have additional costs including but not limited to firearms safety certification, hunting licenses, necessary blaze orange clothing, transportation, etc. Financial assistance is available for qualified candidates.
