1.3 **6262.0200 FISHING REGULATIONS FOR INLAND WATERS.**

1.4 **Subpart 1. General inland fishing regulations.** Fish may be taken in inland waters
1.5 by angling during the time specified for each of the following species; however, certain
1.6 waters of the state are subject to experimental or special regulations or boundary waters
1.7 regulations or are closed for taking and possessing fish. When the closing date of a season
1.8 falls on a Saturday, the season extends through the following Sunday.
