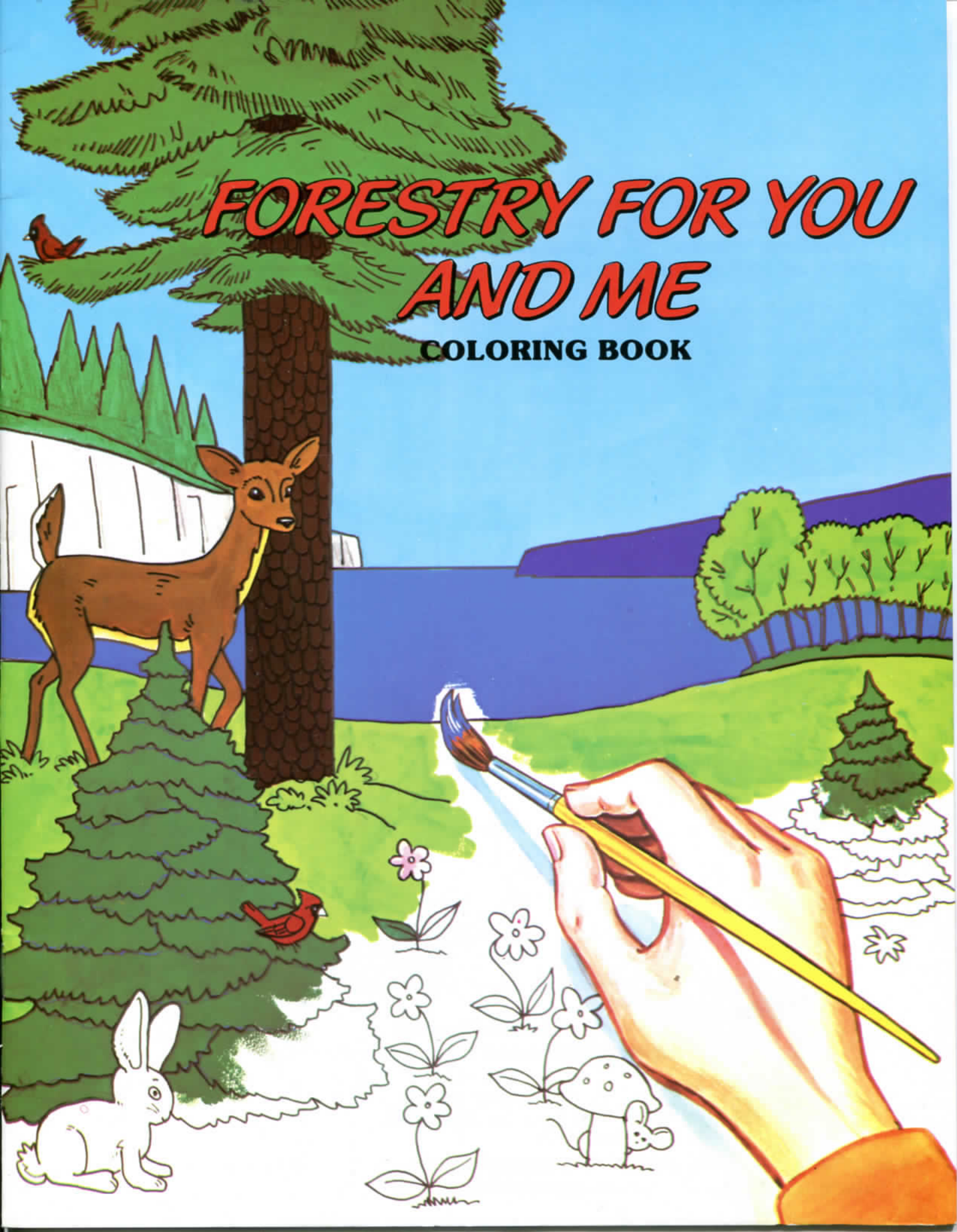

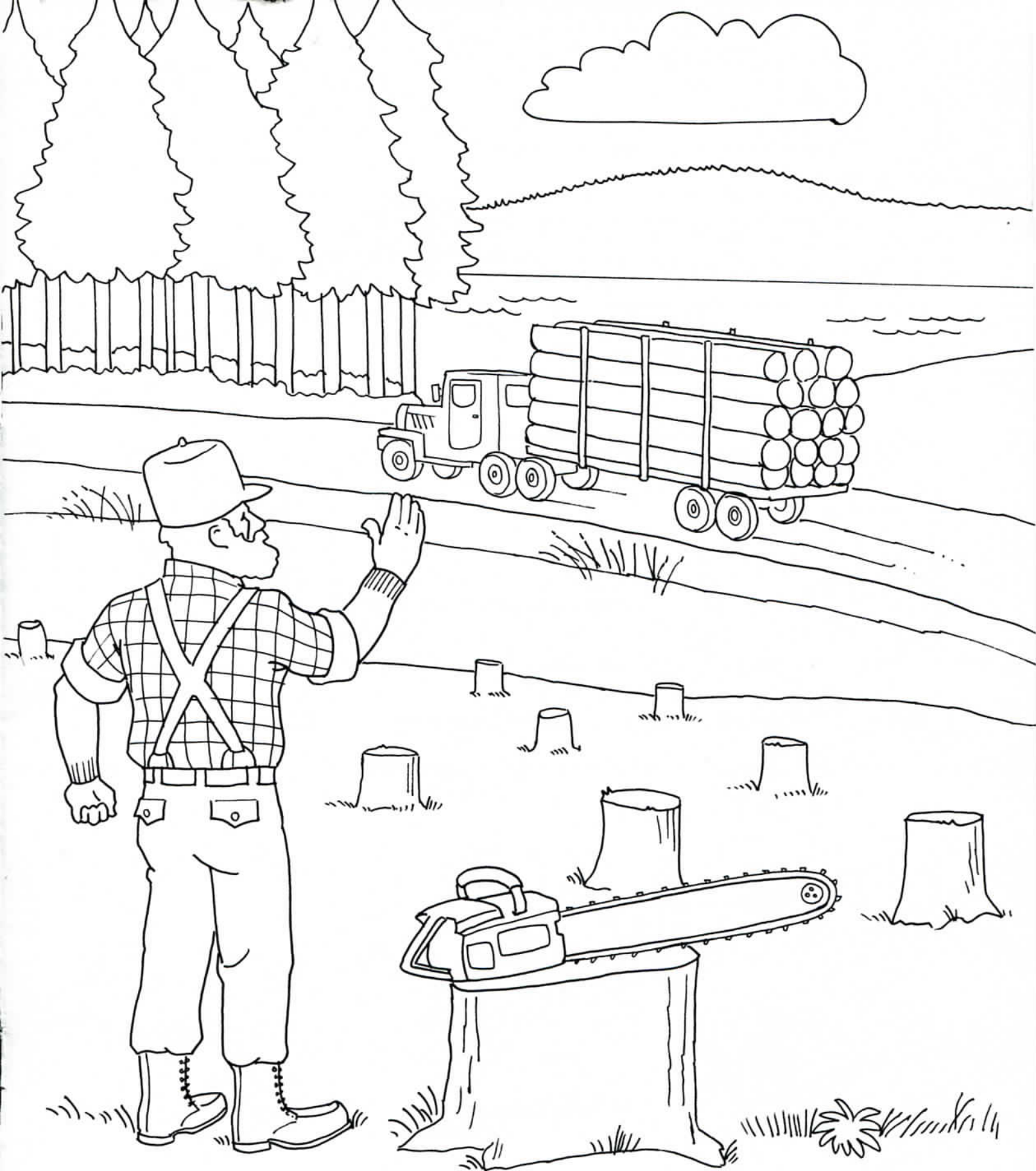

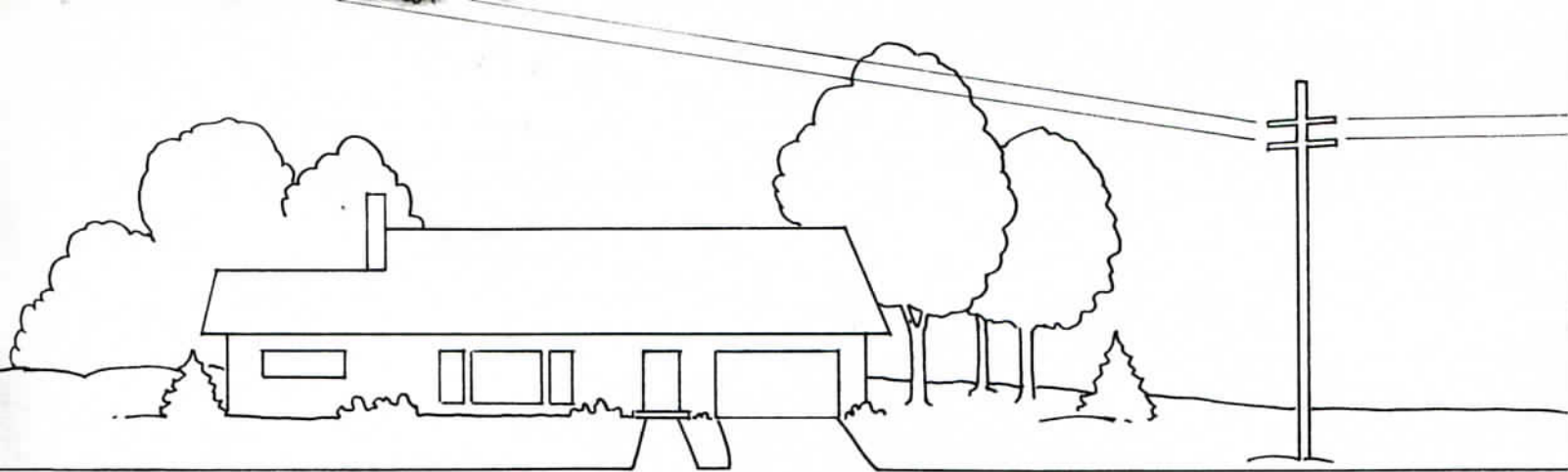
**A careful camper is always sure

but with a whole lot more to do!

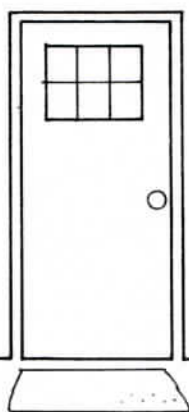


**Aspen, spruce, and jack pine

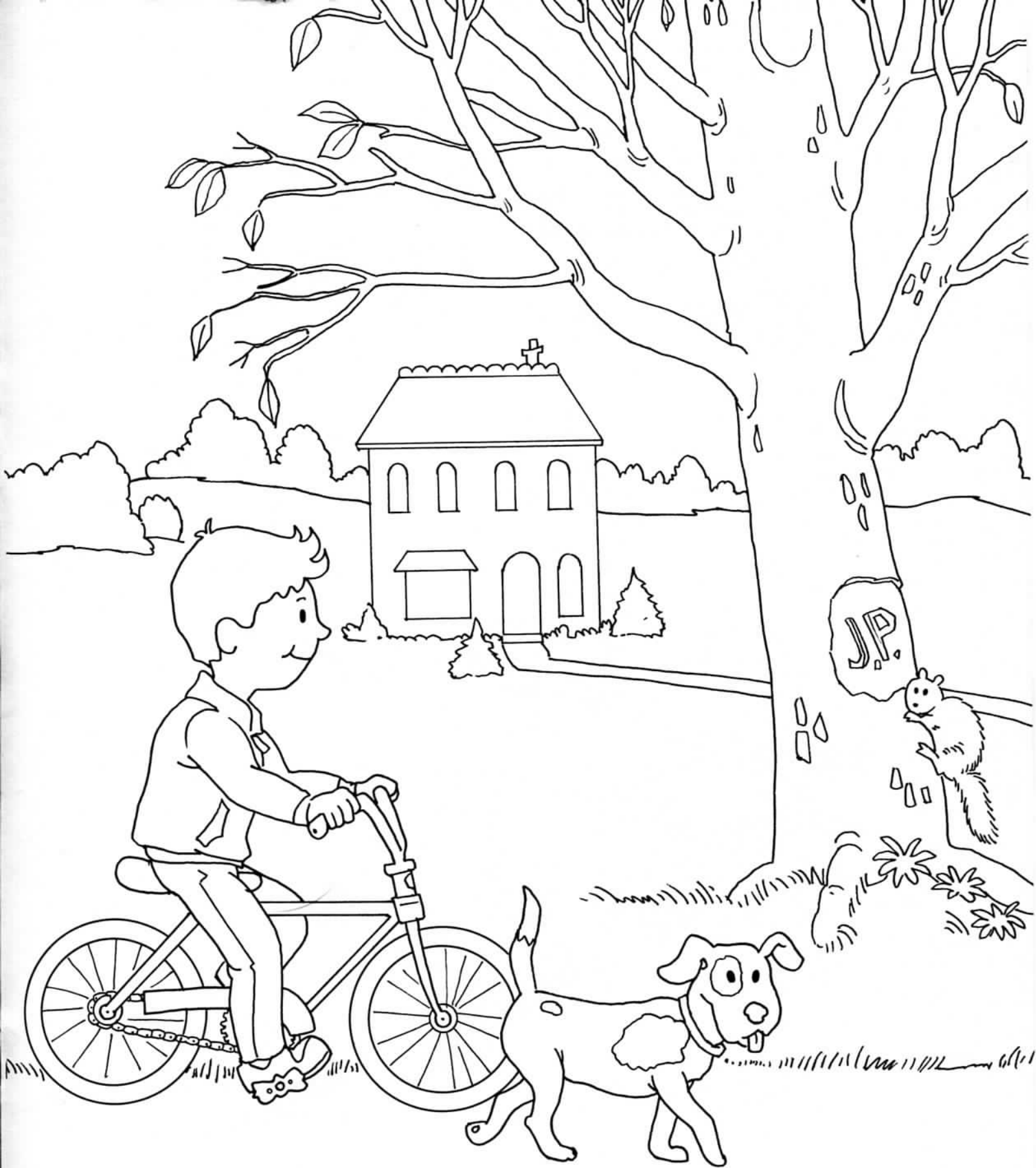
**Forest products touch our lives

to see how many you can name.**



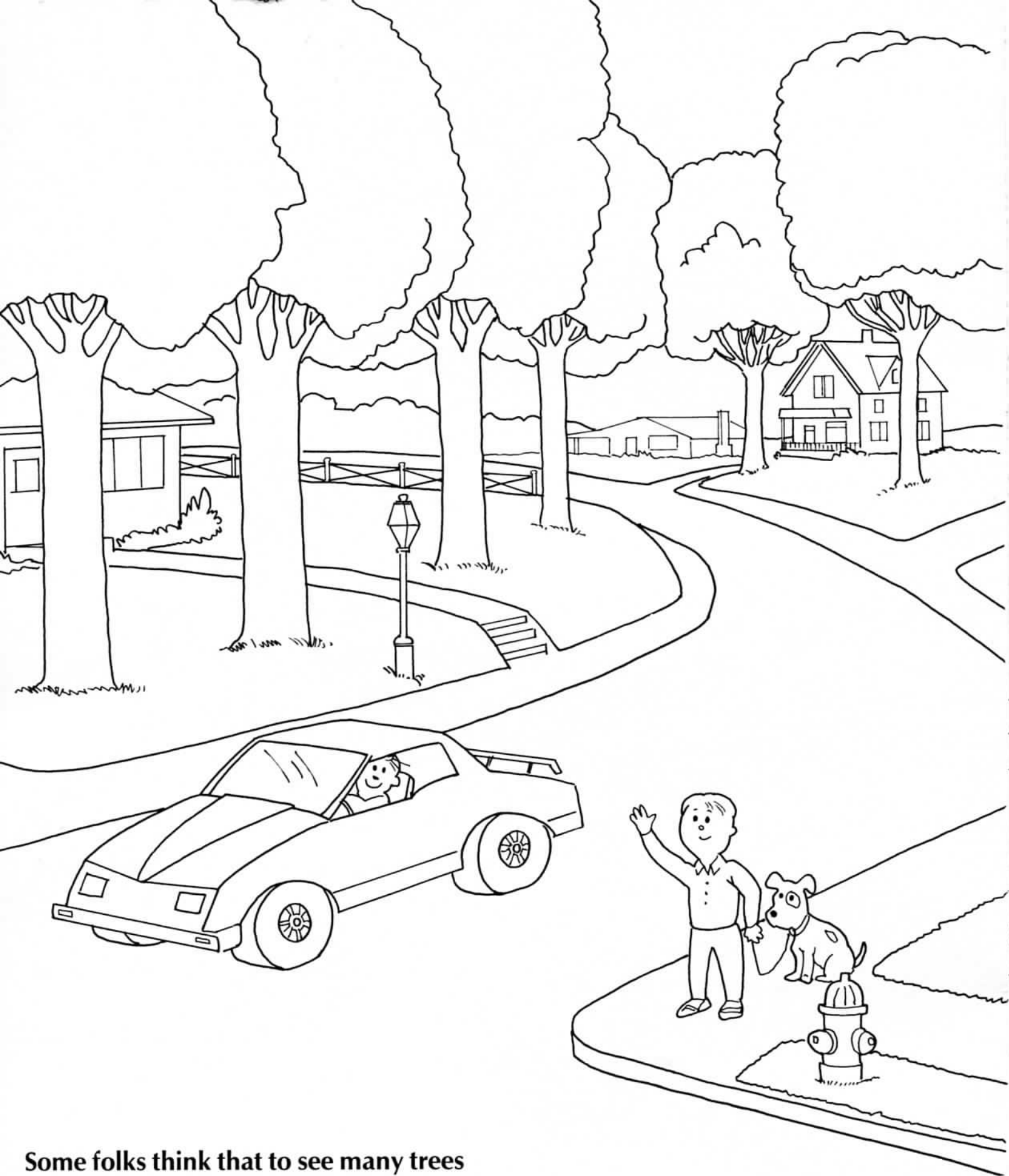
**Just as farmers plant new crops
