

REQUEST FORM – 2024 ADVERSE SURFACE CONDITIONS EMERGENCY EXTENSION

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources has approved an Emergency Extension for 2024 due to Adverse Surface Conditions. 2024 Emergency Adverse Surface Conditions Extensions are available on a permit-by-permit basis. The Emergency Extensions will be granted interest free. To receive an extension, permit holders must submit a request form to the Area Forestry Office that administers the permit. A signed request must be received by a DNR Forestry Office no later than May 31, 2024 or the permit expiration date, whichever is earlier.

Eligibility requirements – To receive the 2024 Emergency Extension, the permit must:

- expire between April 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024,
- be winter-accessible only, and
- have no more than three emergency extensions granted previously.

Emergency Extension Request

Permits that meet the eligibility requirements listed above can request a one-year extension interest free. If you would like to request this extension for one or more eligible permits, list the permit number(s) below:

Submit the completed request form to the DNR Forestry Office administering the permit no later than May 31, 2024 or the permit expiration date, whichever is earlier.
