Attention MN DNR Timber Sale Permit Holders,

Emergency permit extensions due to adverse surface conditions are now available to eligible permits upon request. Extension requests will be reviewed and granted on a permit-by-permit basis. This emergency extension will be granted interest free for one year. To receive an extension, a written, signed request must be received by a DNR Forestry Office no later than May 31, 2024 or the permit expiration date, whichever is earlier.

Eligibility requirements – To receive the 2024 Emergency Extension, the permit must:

- expire between April 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024,
- be winter-accessible only, and
- have no more than three emergency extensions granted previously.

2024 Adverse Surface Conditions Emergency Extension Terms:

- For all winter-accessible only regular, intermediate, and informal permits:
 - The permit holder must submit a written, signed request to the Area Forestry Office administering the permit, the request must be received no later than May 31, 2024 or by the permit expiration date, whichever is earlier. Emergency extension requests received by DNR after the above deadlines will not be granted.

Permit holders will receive a letter from DNR that confirms the extension decision for each eligible permit extension that was requested. All other terms and conditions of the original permit will remain in effect. Please contact your Area Forestry Office if you have any questions.
