The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is accepting comments through October 19, 2023, on an Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) for the removal and replacement of the Lake Bronson Dam, which is in poor condition. The project is located within Lake Bronson State Park, Kittson County, Minnesota. The project includes removal and replacement of the concrete spillway and the associated bridge. The project is located within areas of valuable natural and cultural resources, including a Works Progress Administration historic district.

The EAW was published in the September 19, Environmental Quality Board Monitor.
