As requested, the Minnesota Natural Heritage Information System has been queried to determine if any rare species or other significant natural features are known to occur within an approximate one-mile radius of the proposed project. Based on this query, several rare features have been documented in the search area, mostly between Highway 61 and Lake Superior (all of the rare features on pages 1-3 of the enclosed report are located outside of the project boundary between Hwy 61 and the lake; please visit the Rare Species Guide at http://www.dnr.state.mn.us/rsg/index.html for more information on the biology, habitat use, and conservation measures of these rare species). Given the nature and location of the proposed project, I do not believe the project will negatively affect any known occurrences of rare species. Please note, however, that the following **native plant communities** *may* be impacted by the proposed project:

The proposed campground is within an area that the Minnesota County Biological Survey (MCBS) has identified as a Site of High Biodiversity Significance. Sites of Biodiversity Significance have varying levels of native biodiversity and are ranked based on the relative significance of this biodiversity at a statewide level. Sites ranked as High contain very good quality occurrences of the rarest species, high quality examples of the rare native plant communities, and/or important functional landscapes. This particular Site contains patches of bedrock within an Aspen-Birch Forest (see enclosed map and pages 4 & 5 of the enclosed report; GIS shapefiles of MCBS Sites of Biodiversity Significance and MCBS Native Plant Communities can be downloaded from the DNR Data Deli at http://deli.dnr.state.mn.us). Aspen-Birch Forests and the Crystalline Bedrock Outcrops are common in northeastern Minnesota. The Bedrock Shrubland located in the southeastern portion of the project boundary is a rare native plant community (state rank = 1) that is limited to the North Shore Highlands Subsection of the Northern Superior Uplands. We recommend that the campground be designed to avoid the Bedrock Shrubland and to minimize impacts to the other native plant communities. Indirect impacts from surface runoff or the spread of invasive species should also be considered and minimized to the extent feasible.

The Natural Heritage Information System (NHIS), a collection of databases that contains information about Minnesota's rare natural features, is maintained by the Division of Ecological Resources, Department of Natural Resources. The NHIS is continually updated as new information becomes available, and is the most complete source of data on Minnesota's rare or otherwise significant species, native plant communities, and other natural features. However, the NHIS is not an exhaustive inventory and thus does not represent all of the occurrences of rare features within the state. Therefore, ecologically significant features for which we have no records may exist within the project area.




