The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has prepared an Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) to describe the environmental effects associated with the Star of the North Walking Trail Project, located in Roseau and Lake of the Woods Counties, Minnesota. The production of this document is mandatory. The DNR is the Responsible Governmental Unit for the environmental review of this project.
