Dear Ericka Massa:

Thank you for consulting with our office during the preparation of an Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) for Phase 2 improvements to the Voyageur Country ATV System. According to your submission, the EAW will review 114 miles of trail, which includes preferred routes and alternate alignments. Of the 114 miles of trail, 39 miles are existing routes with no improvements needed, 71 miles are existing routes with some improvements needed, and 4 miles are new routes.

Due to the nature and location of the proposed project, we recommend that a Phase I archaeological survey be completed in areas of proposed new trail construction as well as in areas of proposed trail improvements where new ground disturbance will take place. The survey must meet the requirements of the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Identification and Evaluation and should include an evaluation of National Register eligibility for any properties that are identified. Please note that this comment letter does not address the requirements of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and 36 CFR § 800. If this project is considered for federal financial assistance, or requires a federal permit or license, then review and consultation with our office will need to be initiated by the lead federal agency. Be advised that comments and recommendations provided by our office for this statelevel review may differ from findings and determinations made by the federal agency as part of review and consultation under Section 106.
