

Vehicle Designation
 A-1V: All-terrain Vehicle - restricted recreational vehicles with a seat 7 feet or more than 4 feet in front. Class 1 A-1Vs have an engine displacement of less than 800 cc and seat dry weight of less than 900 pounds. Class 2 A-1Vs have an engine displacement of less than 800 cc and seat dry weight of 900 to 1200 pounds.
 H-1V: Highway Access Vehicle - restricted vehicle that meets the requirements for licensing and use on public highways, including snow, cross-country, motorcycles, etc.
 O-1V: Off-Highway Motorcycle - restricted vehicle for use on public roads and off-road trails.
 O-2V: Off-Highway Vehicle - restricted vehicle for use on public roads and off-road trails.
 O-3V: Off-Highway Vehicle - general term that includes A-1V, O-1V, and O-2V.

Forest Roads
 Forest roads are the primary means of access to public lands. They are not intended for public use and are not to be used for any purpose other than forest management. Forest roads are classified as "Forest Roads" or "Maintenance Roads" depending on their condition and intended use.
