Site Design Questions – 2009

- > Site Use? (Approx. 24% of the site is unusable. Is this workable, acceptable?)
- ➤ Land-use Allocation? (Is use equitably distributed among ATV / OHM / ORV visitors?)
- > Sight / Sound Buffers? (Together, these will restrict use of less than 5% of the area.)
- > Parking / Staging / Gate Access? (No gate planned at Virginia entrance at Gilbert)
- > Special Event Areas (No added Special Event Facilities are planned for the Virginia Site.)
- Surface Water & Wetlands (Water crossings and riparian area set-backs will restrict vehicle use and development of about 400 acres or about 20% of the usable public land area at the Virginia Site)
- > Special Considerations? (e.g., Custodial use of 150 ac MPCA parcel. No Landfill Road crossing or N-S trail connection west of the Landfill are planned. Mesabi Trail crossing is planned.)
- ➤ Unrelated OHV Projects (e.g., Neither the proposed East Range Trail Connection, nor the pending Mesabi Mountain ORV Trail Project are directly linked to completion of this project.)
