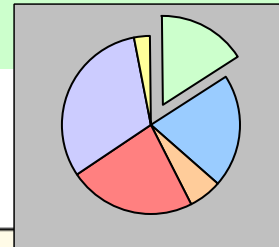


Acquisition (16%)

Purchasing land rights through easements

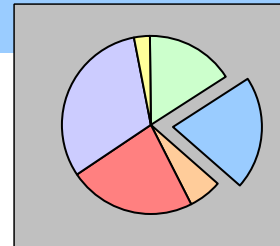


- Allow angler access

Monitoring trout populations and habitat

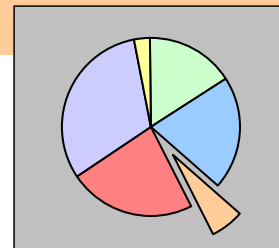


- Identify problems

- Identify trends

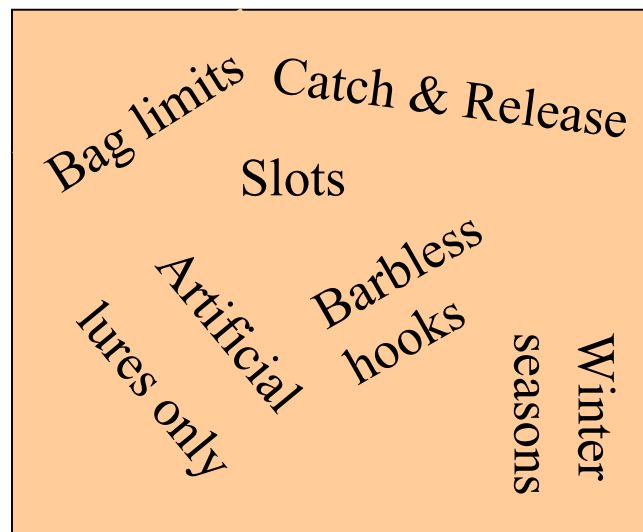


Regulations (6%)

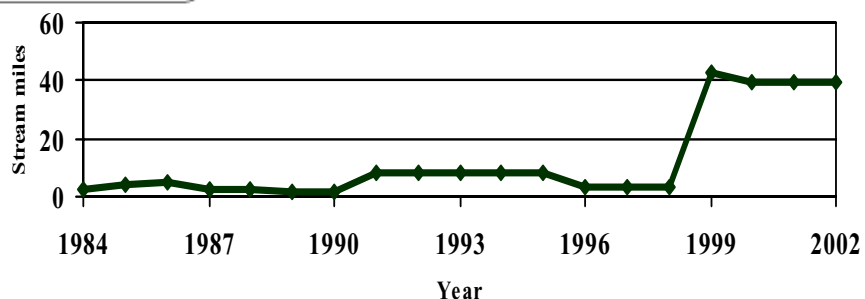
Managing trout harvest

- Experimental and special regulations

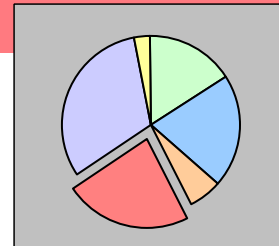


Stream miles with experimental regulations

Adding trout for a specific purpose

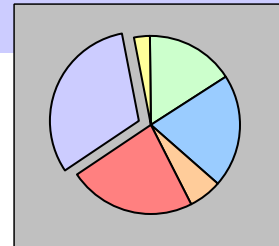


- Good adult habitat but low reproductive success

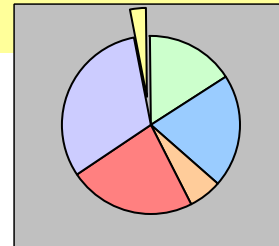
