1.3 **6216.0250 PROHIBITED INVASIVE SPECIES.**

1.4 *[For text of subpart 1, see Minnesota Rules]*

1.5 Subp. 2. **Aquatic plants.** The following aquatic plants are designated as prohibited
1.6 invasive species:

1.7 A. African oxygen weed (*Lagarosiphon major*) (Ridley) Moss ex Wagner;

1.8 B. aquarium watermoss or giant salvinia (*Salvinia molesta*) Mitchell;

1.9 C. Australian stonecrop (*Crassula helmsii*) (Kirk) Cockayne;

1.10 D. brittle naiad (*Najas minor*) Allioni;

1.11 E. common reed, nonnative subspecies (*Phragmites australis* ssp. *australis*, not
1.12 including *Phragmites australis* ssp. *americanus*) (Cav.) Trin. ex Steud;

1.13 F. curly-leaf pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*) Linnaeus;

1.14 G. Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*) Linnaeus, including its hybrids;

1.15 H. European frog-bit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*) Linnaeus;

1.16 I. flowering rush (*Butomus umbellatus*) Linnaeus;

1.17 J. hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillata*) (Carl von Linnaeus) Royle;

1.18 K. Indian swampweed (*Hygrophila polysperma*) (Roxburgh) T. Anders;

1.19 L. purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*, *Lythrum virgatum*, or any variety, hybrid,
1.20 or cultivar thereof) Linnaeus;

1.21 M. starry stonewort (*Nitellopsis obtusa*) (N.A. Desvaux) J. Groves;

1.22 N. water aloe or water soldiers (*Stratiotes aloides*) Linnaeus;

2.1 O. water chestnut (*Trapa natans*) Linnaeus; and

2.2 P. yellow floating heart (*Nymphoides peltata*) (S.G. Gmel.) Kuntze.

2.3 Subp. 2a. **Federal noxious weed list.** Aquatic plants listed in Code of Federal
2.4 Regulations, title 7, section 360.200, are designated as prohibited invasive species, except
2.5 for Chinese water spinach (*Ipomoea aquatica*) Forsskal.

2.6 Subp. 3. **Fish.** The following fish are designated as prohibited invasive species:

2.7 A. Amur sleeper (*Perccottus glenii*) Dybowski;

2.8 B. bighead carp (*Hypophthalmichthys nobilis*) Richardson;

2.9 C. black carp (*Mylopharyngodon piceus*) (Richardson) Peters;

2.10 D. crucian carp (*Carassius carassius*) Linnaeus;

2.11 E. Eastern mosquitofish (*Gambusia holbrooki*) Girard;

2.12 F. Eurasian minnow (*Phoxinus phoxinus*) Linnaeus;

2.13 G. European perch (*Perca fluviatilis*) Linnaeus;

2.14 H. grass carp (*Ctenopharyngodon idella*) Valenciennes;

2.15 I. largescale silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys harmandi*) Sauvage;

2.16 J. northern snakehead fish (*Channa argus*) Cantor;

2.17 K. Oriental weatherfish (*Misgurnus anguillicaudatus*) Cantor;

2.18 L. Prussian carp (*Carassius gibelio*) Bloch;

2.19 M. roach (*Rutilus rutilus*) Linnaeus;

2.20 N. round goby (*Neogobius melanostomus*);

2.21 O. rudd (*Scardinius erythrophthalmus*) Linnaeus;

- 3.1 P. ruffe (*Gymnocephalus cernuus*) Linnaeus;
- 3.2 Q. sea lamprey (*Petromyzon marinus*) Linnaeus;
- 3.3 R. silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*) Valenciennes;

- 3.9 W. western mosquitofish (*Gambusia affinis*) Baird & Girard;
- 3.10 X. white perch (*Morone americana*) Gmelin; and
- 3.11 Y. zander (*Sander lucioperca*) or (*Stizostedion lucioperca*) Linnaeus.

3.12 Subp. 3a. **Federal injurious wildlife list; fish.** Fish listed in Code of Federal

3.13 Regulations, title 50, section 16.13, are designated as prohibited invasive species, except

3.14 for salmonids listed as unregulated nonnative species in part 6216.0270.

3.15 Subp. 4. **Invertebrates.** The following invertebrates are designated as prohibited

3.16 invasive species:

- 3.17 A. faucet snail (*Bithynia tentaculata*) Linnaeus;
- 3.18 B. golden clam (*Corbicula fluminea*) O.F. Müller;
- 3.19 C. golden mussel (*Limnoperna fortunei*) Dunker;
- 3.20 D. jumping worms (*Amyntas* and *Metaphire* spp.) Kinberg;
- 3.21 E. marbled crayfish (marmorkrebs) (*Procambarus virginalis* or *Procambarus*
- 3.22 *fallax forma virginalis*);

- 4.1 F. New Zealand mud snail (*Potamopyrgus antipodarum*) Gray;
- 4.2 G. quagga mussel (*Dreissena bugensis*) Andrusov;
- 4.3 H. red swamp crayfish (*Procambarus clarkii*) Girard;
- 4.4 I. yabby (*Cherax destructor*) Clark; and
- 4.5 J. zebra mussel (*Dreissena* spp.).

4.6 Subp. 4a. **Federal injurious wildlife list; mollusks and crustaceans.** Mollusks and
4.7 crustaceans listed in Code of Federal Regulations, title 50, section 16.13, are designated as
4.8 prohibited invasive species.

4.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The designation of jumping worms in Minnesota Rules, part
4.11 6216.0250, subpart 4, item D, is effective July 1, 2024.
