This Web site hosts the Nevada Standardized Reclamation Cost Estimator (SRCE) software that was developed in accordance with guidance developed during the implementation of the Nevada **Standardized Unit Cost** Project, a cooperative effort between the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation (NDEP), the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Nevada Mining Association (NvMA) to facilitate accuracy, completeness and consistency in the calculation of costs for mine site reclamation.

The project was implemented largely on a voluntary basis with initial funding provided the NvMA. The SRCE software continues to be developed and supported on a voluntary basis, and the model is publicly available free of charge.
