Location:

- Located in the Kabetogama State Forest, 28 miles north of Orr, 25 miles south of International Falls on Highway 53, then 6 miles north on County Road 122.

Camping Facilities:

- 61 campsites (non-electrical) – most can accommodate large RV's. Ample grass for tent sites – each site has a picnic table and fire ring.
- Two campsites are handicapped accessible.
- 6 vault-type toilets.
- Drinking water is piped to several locations throughout the camping area.
- Docks at two locations for temporary camper use.
- Firewood; gathering of dead and down material is allowed. There are also several places in the surrounding community where firewood can be purchased. Firewood must be DNR-Certified
- Camping fee required nightly.

Day Use Facilities

- Public access; double-wide ramp and dock.
- Picnic area; located on a pine-covered shoreline, can accommodate large groups and offers quiet, private sites for smaller groups.
- Swimming area; sand beach, open lawn, no lifeguard on duty.
- Toilets with changing areas available near beach.

Voyaguers National Park (VNP) interpretive programs.

- Several VNP interpretive ranger programs are held during the week, most of which are based out of the Woodenfrog Refectory. Programs can potentially include nature hikes, twilight walks, campfire talks, and historical reenactments. Information about programs and activities is posted on campground bulletin boards and at the Refectory. Other state forest camping opportunities.

- Ash River State Forest Campground – 10 miles east of State Highway 53 on County Road 129. Nine drive-in sites, picnic area, water access. Fee charged.
