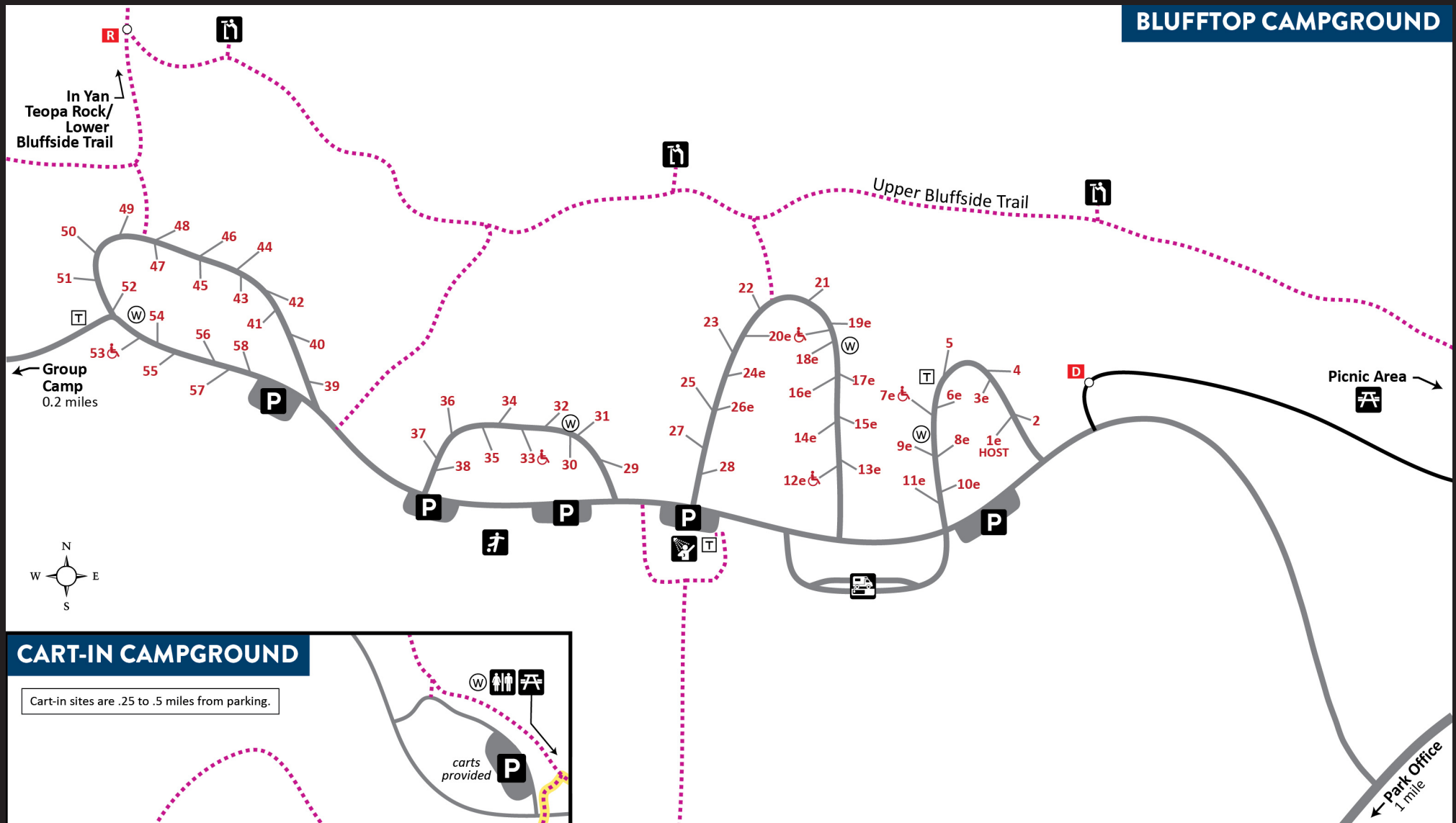
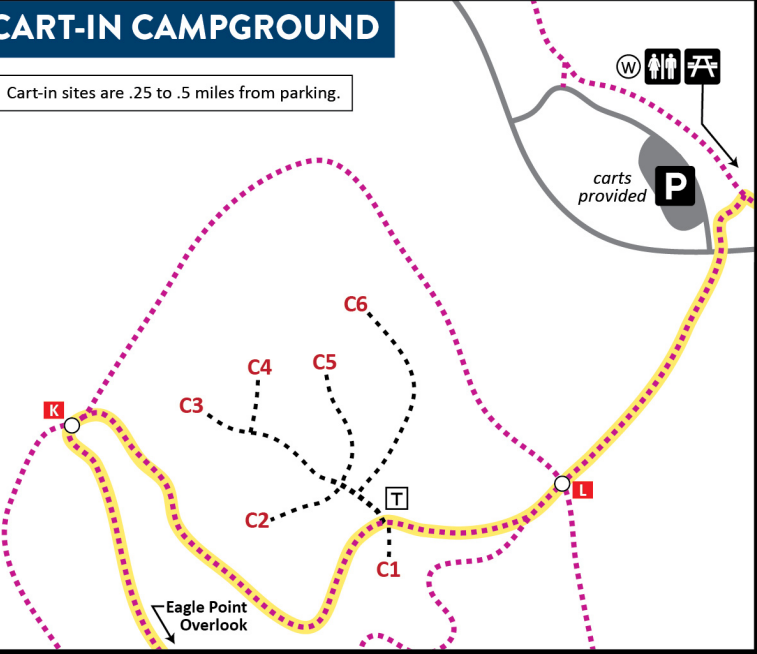


BLUFFTOP CAMPGROUND

CAMPGROUND RULES

So Everyone Can Enjoy the Campground, Please Observe the Following Rules:

- No more than 6 people may occupy a site.
- The gathering of firewood is prohibited, it may be purchased at the main office.
- Check-out is at 4 pm. Please leave the site clean and pick up any trash or firewood scraps before leaving.

Vehicle Speed

- The speed limit in the campground is 10 MPH. Watch out for kids.

Parking

- Vehicles can only be parked on the parking spur of campsite, not in tent area, on the grass, or on the road.
- Visitors must use the available overflow parking lots.
- Rule of 3: any combination of vehicles and tents are allowed that does not exceed 3. (2 tents, 1 car), (2 cars, 1 tent), etc.

Alcohol

- It is unlawful to consume or display intoxicating beverages in all Minnesota State Parks.

Quiet Hours

- No loud voices, radios, or generators allowed from 10 pm-8 am.
- Only registered guests are allowed in the park after 10 pm.

Generators

- Not allowed during quiet hours (see above).
- Intermittent use to charge batteries/cook meals is okay. They will need to be turned off at the discretion of park manager or security if used in excess.

Pets

- Keep pets leashed, attended to and effectively restrained at all times.
- Pets are not allowed in park buildings.

Trash

- Place trash in designated trash bins.
- DO NOT PUT TRASH IN FIRE RINGS OR PIT TOILETS.

Fireworks

- No fireworks or explosives of any kind are allowed.

Hammock Guidelines - to reduce tree impact

- Not all campsite are suitable for hammocks, please call park for details.
- Potential trees on site MUST have a diameter of 12" or more to attach a hammock.
- Trees and hammocks MUST be completely within the designated campsite (mowed or graveled area).
- Strap width MUST be a minimum of 1" though 2" is preferred.
- No more than one hammock strap per tree.
- If tree bark shows damage, extra padding must be placed between strap and tree.

Please help us protect the trees and ground vegetation from damage.
