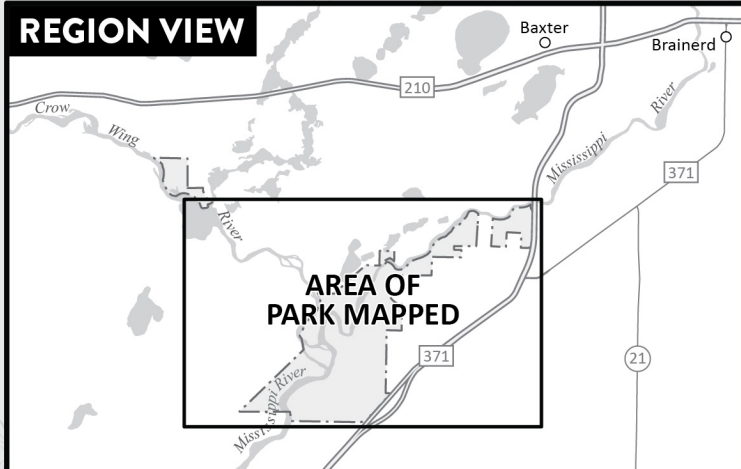

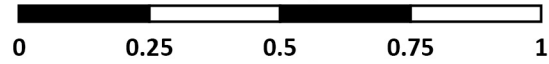

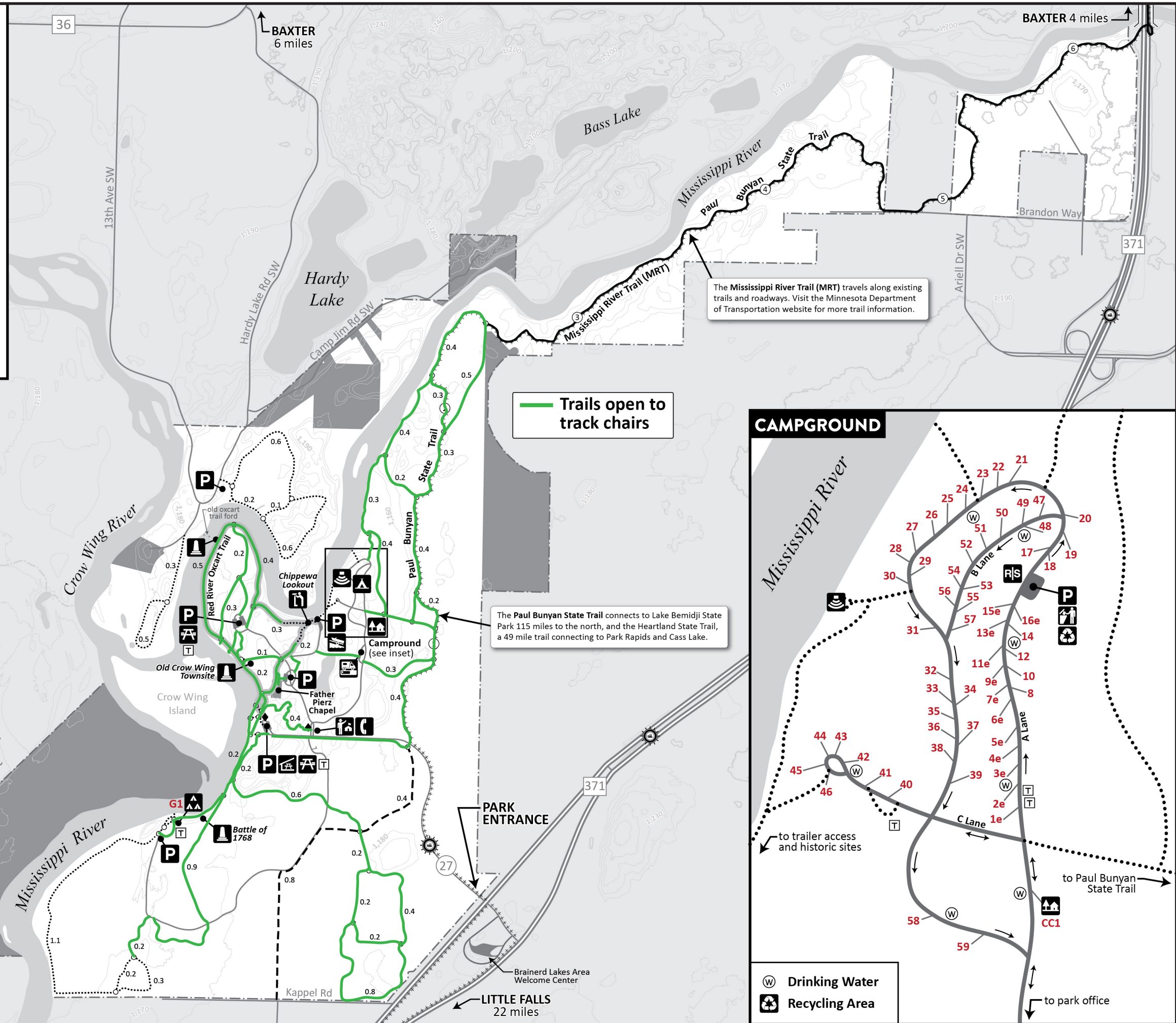
AREA OF

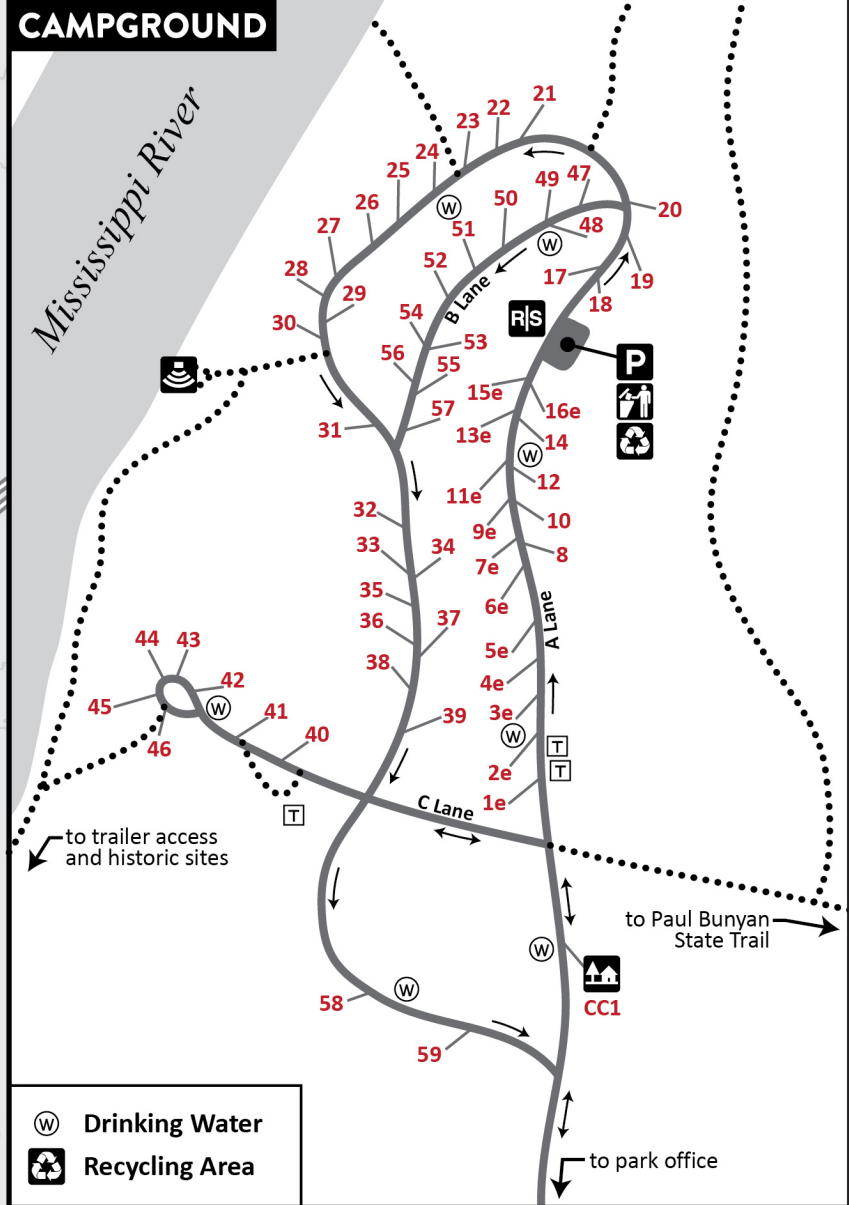
