2016 Authorization to Print Supplementary Aquatic Invasive Species Signs

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) allows local governments to print these supplementary Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) signs to post at water accesses.

1. Receive permission from the water access owners. Find ownership information using [LakeFinder](#).
2. Complete the form below and provide a copy to the company printing the signs. Send a copy to the DNR at 500 Lafayette Road, Box 25, St. Paul MN 55155, "ATTN: AIS sign printing" or email an electronic copy to Tina.Wolbers@state.mn.us. Sign artwork files will be emailed to you and the printing company after the DNR receives this completed form.
