<i>Nuphar variegata</i>	Yellow Water Lily
<i>Nymphaea odorata</i> ssp. <i>tuberosa</i>	White Water Lily
<i>Potamogeton amplifolius</i>	Large-leaved Pondweed, Cabbage
* <i>Potamogeton epihydrus</i>	Ribbon-leaved Pondweed
* <i>Potamogeton gramineus</i>	Variable Pondweed
<i>Sparganium fluctuans</i>	Wide Floatingleaf Burreed

<i>Calla palustris</i>	Wild calla
<i>Dulichium arundinaceum</i>	Three-way sedge
* <i>Eleocharis palustris</i>	Small's Spikerush
* <i>Equisetum fluviatile</i>	Water horsetail
* <i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
<i>Schoenoplectus subterminalis</i>	Subterminally Fruited Bulrush
<i>Typha latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved cattail

Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)
