<i>Potamogeton foliosus</i> ssp. <i>foliosus</i>	Leafy Pondweed

<i>Potamogeton pusillus</i>	Very Small Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton robbinsii</i>	Robbins' Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton strictifolius</i>	Straightleaved Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton zosteriformis</i>	Flatstem Pondweed
<i>Stuckenia pectinata</i>	Common Sago Pondweed
<i>Vallisneria americana</i>	Wild Celery, Eel-grass

**Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)**

<i>Nuphar variegata</i>	Yellow Water Lily
<i>Nymphaea odorata</i> ssp. <i>tuberosa</i>	White Water Lily
<i>Potamogeton amplifolius</i>	Large-leaved Pondweed, Cabbage
<i>Potamogeton gramineus</i>	Variable Pondweed
* <i>Potamogeton natans</i>	Floating Leaf Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton nodosus</i>	River Pondweed

**Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)**

<i>Eleocharis palustris</i>	Small's Spikerush
<i>Equisetum fluviatile</i>	Water horsetail
cf <i>Sagittaria cristata</i>	Crested arrowhead
<i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
<i>Schoenoplectus acutus</i> var. <i>acutus</i>	Hard-stem bulrush
<i>Schoenoplectus tabernaemontani</i>	Soft-stem bulrush

**Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)**

<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Red-osier dogwood
<i>Eleocharis acicularis</i>	Needle Spike-rush
<i>Impatiens capensis</i>	Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not
<i>Juncus pelocarpus</i>	Mud-fruit Rush
<i>Leersia oryzoides</i>	Rice cut grass
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
<i>Scirpus atrovirens</i>	Dark-green Bulrush
