Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

* <i>Acorus americanus</i>	Sweet Flag
* <i>Alisma</i> sp.	Water Plantain; Mud Plantain
<i>Bolboschoenus fluviatilis</i>	River Bulrush
<i>Carex utriculata</i>	Beaked Sedge, Bottle-shaped
<i>Dulichium arundinaceum</i>	Three-way sedge
<i>Eleocharis erythropoda</i>	Bald spikerush
* <i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
<i>Schoenoplectus tabernaemontani</i>	Soft-stem bulrush
* <i>Sparganium eurycarpum</i>	Giant Burreed
<i>Typha angustifolia</i>	Narrow-leaved cat-tail
* <i>Zizania palustris</i>	Wild rice
