* <i>Ranunculus aquatilis</i> var. <i>diffusus</i>	White water-crowfoot
<i>Vallisneria americana</i>	Wild Celery, Eel-grass

Free-floating Plants (Plants that float freely on the water surface)

* <i>Lemna trisulca</i>	Ivy-leaved duckweed
<i>Lemna turionifera</i>	Turion-forming Duckweed

Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)

<i>Nuphar variegata</i>	Yellow Water Lily

* <i>Potamogeton amplifolius</i>	Large-leaved Pondweed, Cabbage
* <i>Potamogeton gramineus</i>	Variable Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton spirillus</i>	Snailseed Pondweed
<i>Sparganium angustifolium</i>	Narrow Floatingleaf Burreed
* <i>Sparganium fluctuans</i>	Wide Floatingleaf Burreed

Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

* <i>Eleocharis palustris</i>	Small's Spikerush
* <i>Equisetum fluviatile</i>	Water horsetail
* <i>Glyceria borealis</i>	Northern manna grass
<i>Sagittaria rigida</i>	Stiff Wapato, Sessile-fruited
<i>Schoenoplectus acutus</i> var. <i>acutus</i>	Hard-stem bulrush
* <i>Schoenoplectus tabernaemontani</i>	Soft-stem bulrush
* <i>Sparganium eurycarpum</i>	Giant Burreed
<i>Typha latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved cattail
<i>Zizania palustris</i>	Wild rice
