<i>Utricularia intermedia</i>	Intermediate bladderwort
<i>Utricularia vulgaris</i>	Greater bladderwort

<i>Sparganium angustifolium</i>	Narrow Floatingleaf Burreed
<i>Sparganium fluctuans</i>	Wide Floatingleaf Burreed
