<i>Utricularia vulgaris</i>	Greater bladderwort
<i>Vallisneria americana</i>	Wild Celery, Eel-grass

Free-floating Plants (Plants that float freely on the water surface)

<i>Impatiens capensis</i>	Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not
<i>Iris versicolor</i>	Blue Flag
<i>Lycopus americanus</i>	Cut-leaved bugleweed
<i>Lysimachia terrestris</i>	Swamp Candles, Loosestrife
* <i>Myosotis laxa</i>	Smaller forget-me-not
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
* <i>Rumex triangulivalvis</i>	Willow-leaved dock
<i>Salix lucida</i>	Shining willow
