**Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)**

*Eleocharis erythropoda* Bald spikerush  
*Phragmites australis* Common reed grass, Cane  
*Sagittaria latifolia* Broad-leaved Arrowhead  
*Schoenoplectus acutus* var. *acutus* Hard-stem bulrush  
*Schoenoplectus tabernaemontani* Soft-stem bulrush  
*Sparganium eurycarpum* Giant Burreed  
*Typha angustifolia* Narrow-leaved cat-tail  
*Typha latifolia* Broad-leaved cattail

**Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)**

*Asclepias incarnata* Swamp milkweed  
*Carex comosa* Bottlebrush sedge
