Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)

<i>Nymphaea odorata</i> ssp. <i>tuberosa</i>	White Water Lily
<i>Potamogeton nodosus</i>	River Pondweed

Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

<i>Eleocharis erythropoda</i>	Bald spikerush
<i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
<i>Sagittaria rigida</i>	Stiff Wapato, Sessile-fruited

<i>Bidens sp.</i>	Bur-Marigold; Beggar-Tick

* <i>Carex hystericina</i>	Porcupine-like Sedge
<i>Carex interior</i>	Inland sedge
<i>Eleocharis acicularis</i>	Needle Spike-rush
<i>Lysimachia terrestris</i>	Swamp Candles, Loosestrife
* <i>Osmunda regalis var. spectabilis</i>	Royal fern
