<i>Potamogeton epihydrus</i>	Ribbon-leaved Pondweed
<i>Sagittaria cuneata</i>	Floating Leaf Arrowhead
<i>Sparganium angustifolium</i>	Narrow Floatingleaf Burreed

<i>Calla palustris</i>	Wild calla

<i>Typha latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved cattail

<i>Chamaedaphne calyculata</i>	Leather-leaf
<i>Cicuta bulbifera</i>	Bulb-bearing water-hemlock
<i>Drosera rotundifolia</i>	Round-leaved sundew
<i>Eutrochium maculatum</i>	Spotted Joe-pye weed
<i>Impatiens capensis</i>	Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not
<i>Iris versicolor</i>	Blue Flag
<i>Lycopus uniflorus</i>	Northern bugleweed
<i>Lysimachia terrestris</i>	Swamp Candles, Loosestrife
<i>Menyanthes trifoliata</i>	Buck-bean
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
<i>Potentilla palustris</i>	Marsh cinquefoil
<i>Scirpus cyperinus</i>	Wool-grass
<i>Scirpus microcarpus</i>	Red-tinged bulrush
