<i>Potamogeton strictifolius</i>	Straightleaved Pondweed

<i>Stuckenia filiformis</i>	Blunt-tipped Sago Pondweed

Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)

<i>Potamogeton amplifolius</i>	Large-leaved Pondweed, Cabbage
<i>Sparganium angustifolium</i>	Narrow Floatingleaf Burreed

Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

<i>Eleocharis erythropoda</i>	Bald spikerush
<i>Sagittaria rigida</i>	Stiff Wapato, Sessile-fruited

Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)

<i>Asclepias incarnata</i>	Swamp milkweed
<i>Bidens</i> sp.	Bur-Marigold; Beggar-Ticks
<i>Carex stipata</i>	Crowded Sedge
<i>Glyceria grandis</i>	Tall manna grass
<i>Impatiens capensis</i>	Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not
<i>Juncus tenuis</i>	Path rush
<i>Lycopus americanus</i>	Cut-leaved bugleweed
<i>Lycopus uniflorus</i>	Northern bugleweed
<i>Mentha arvensis</i> var. <i>canadensis</i>	Common mint
<i>Myosotis scorpioides</i>	True forget-me-not
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
<i>Salix</i> sp.	Willow
<i>Scirpus atrovirens</i>	Dark-green Bulrush
