<i>Potamogeton richardsonii</i>	Claspingleaf Pondweed
<i>Potamogeton zosteriformis</i>	Flatstem Pondweed
* <i>Stuckenia filiformis</i> ssp. <i>occidentalis</i>	Blunt-tipped Sago Pondweed
* <i>Stuckenia pectinata</i>	Common Sago Pondweed
* <i>Utricularia vulgaris</i>	Greater bladderwort

Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)

<i>Nuphar variegata</i>	Yellow Water Lily
* <i>Potamogeton natans</i>	Floating Leaf Pondweed

Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

cf <i>Eleocharis erythropoda</i>	Bald spikerush
<i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
* <i>Schoenoplectus acutus</i> var. <i>acutus</i>	Hard-stem bulrush
<i>Sparganium</i> sp.	Burreed
<i>Typha latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved cattail
<i>Zizania palustris</i>	Wild rice

Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)

<i>Bidens</i> sp.	Bur-Marigold; Beggar-Tick
<i>Bidens cernua</i>	Nodding bur-marigold
<i>Carex pseudocyperus</i>	False Cyperus sedge
<i>Cicuta bulbifera</i>	Bulb-bearing water-hemlock
<i>Cyperus diandrus</i>	Two-stamened Nut-grass
* <i>Cyperus odoratus</i>	Engelmann's Nut-grass
<i>Cyperus squarrosus</i>	Awned Nut-grass
<i>Eleocharis acicularis</i>	Needle Spike-rush
<i>Impatiens capensis</i>	Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not
<i>Leersia oryzoides</i>	Rice cut grass
<i>Lycopus uniflorus</i>	Northern bugleweed
<i>Persicaria lapathifolia</i>	Nodding smartweed
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
<i>Scutellaria lateriflora</i>	Mad-dog skullcap
