<i>Utricularia vulgaris</i>	Greater bladderwort
<i>Vallisneria americana</i>	Wild Celery, Eel-grass

*Lemna turionifera* Turion-forming Duckweed

**Floating-leaf Plants (Plants with leaves that float on the water surface)**

*Brasenia schreberi* Water shield  
*Nymphaea odorata* ssp. *tuberosa* White Water Lily  
*Potamogeton amplifolius* Large-leaved Pondweed, Cabbage  
*Potamogeton spirillus* Snailseed Pondweed  
*Potamogeton vaseyi* Vasey's Pondweed

**Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)**

*Carex utriculata* Beaked Sedge, Bottle-shaped  
*Dulichium arundinaceum* Three-way sedge  
*Eleocharis palustris* Small's Spikerush  
*Equisetum fluviatile* Water horsetail  
*Sagittaria latifolia* Broad-leaved Arrowhead  
\* *Schoenoplectus torreyi* Torey's bulrush  
*Typha latifolia* Broad-leaved cattail

**Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)**

*Bidens* sp. Bur-Marigold; Beggar-Ticks  
*Calamagrostis canadensis* Blue-joint  
*Cicuta bulbifera* Bulb-bearing water-hemlock  
*Galium* sp. Bedstraw; Cleavers  
*Impatiens capensis* Jewelweed, Spotted touch-me-not  
*Juncus pelocarpus* Mud-fruit Rush  
*Lysimachia terrestris* Swamp Candles, Loosestrife  
*Phalaris arundinacea* Reed canary grass  
*Scirpus atrocinctus* Black-spiked bulrush  
*Scirpus cyperinus* Wool-grass
