



## The Watershed Exploration Process: [mndnr.gov/whaf/explore](http://mndnr.gov/whaf/explore)

- 1 Set a point of interest** - Start by setting a location, this will allow you visualize watershed boundaries and data specific to that location.
- 2 Explore watershed boundaries at multiple spatial scales** - Each button provides the ability to visualize and zoom to watershed boundaries at different scales. Also, access land cover summaries from the scale button drop-down menu.
- 3 Investigate watershed health scores** - Health scores are organized by ecological component in an accordion style menu. Be sure to expand each component to view all of the available scores.
- 4 Access additional data layers** - Additional map layers can be added from a list of DNR services, or 3rd party services can be added to the map via the service REST endpoint.
- 5 Save bookmarks and share URLs** - Bookmarks save the current map view to your web browser cache, URLs can be shared to view the map on a different computer or by a different user.
- 6 Dive deeper with additional resources** - Additional content includes instructions to help use the application, access to the health score data download, and descriptions of input data and analysis methods.
