Fillmore County was very lightly glaciated and is practically devoid of natural lake basins. The only natural lake listed, 23-2, is a small boggy area which has discernible banks but usually does not contain standing water. Both lakes listed are affected by drainage or dry.

There are several impoundments behind dams in streams that are confined within stream banks and create no reservoirs of notable size. Lanesboro Mill Pond, listed above, has been completely filled with silt and ineffective for 30 years or more. A Farrington Lake is mentioned in publications as located in T. 104 N., R. 12 W., Section 24, and having the Root River running through it. As it cannot be discerned on either the aerial photographs or topographic maps, its size cannot be determined.
