

# KITTSON COUNTY (35)

Number of lakes . . . . . 5  
 Lake area, acres. . . . . 829

There are very few lakes in Kittson County. Upper and Lower Twin Lakes, 35-1 and 35-2, are directly related to a collapsed portion of beaches deposited by Glacial Lake Agassiz which crosses the southeastern part of the county. They occupy shallow basins between a series of beach ridges. The water levels in these lakes are maintained by ground water seepage from the ridges. Scull, 35-4, is in a region which was once part of an extensive marshy area. Bronson, 35-3, is a reservoir formed by a dam on the South Fork of Two Rivers which was completed in 1938. It is located in Lake Bronson State Park.
