MINNESOTA STATE CERTIFIED WEIGHT RECORD FISH RULES AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To be considered for a Minnesota Catch and Release record, anglers must follow all instructions below. Please print clearly when filling out the application. Incomplete applications may be returned or rejected.


- Fish may not be caught using any methods other than angling and may not be snagged.
- Fish caught from any fish hatchery (private, club or government) are not eligible to be considered for a state record. Fish caught on a body of water without a public access are not eligible to be considered for a state record.
- Fish must be caught during the legal open season and hours in Minnesota waters, including those boundary waters where a Minnesota Fishing License is valid, by a person licensed or otherwise legally entitled to angle in Minnesota.
- Fish must be released in good condition.
- Witness to the catch is mandatory. Witness information must be provided on the application form.
- Length measurements must be clear and documented with photos. The length of the fish must be measured in a straight flat line from the tip of the snout to the tip of the tail with the tail squeezed. Photograph the fish next to, or on top of, a flat measuring stick, ruler, or tape that clearly shows the snout lined up with zero and the pinched tail (see photo). The entire length of the measuring device must be seen in the photo. Any questionable measurements will not be accepted. All photographs become property of the State, will not be returned, and may be used for promotional purposes.
- The girth of the fish, measured around the thickest portion of the body, is desired, but optional.
- Applications must be submitted within 90 days of the date on which the fish was caught.

Applications are not approved until all information is received and verified by the DNR Fisheries. The Department of Natural Resources reserves the right to verify identification, verify that the applicant held a valid fishing license at the time of capture, verify witness identify, investigate catch documentation, and reject any applications that are incomplete or not able to be verified.
