

### APPLICATION TO CONDUCT A FISHING TOURNAMENT

**INSTRUCTIONS:** 

1. Complete all information requested below and sign.

#### 2. Submit the permit fee and a copy of the Tournament Rules with this application.

- Permit applications will be accepted from August 1 for tournaments being held the following year. Complete applications received before the last Friday in September will be eligible for a drawing if more applications are received for a given waterbody than available permits. Other applications will be handled on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Permit fees are \$50 for youth (all participants 18 or younger), \$70 for small tournaments (50 or fewer boats or shore-based tournaments), \$225 for large tournaments (more than 50 boats), or \$135 for ice tournaments. Off-site weigh-in fees are \$280 for small tournaments or \$560 for large tournaments. Submit fee with this application. See DNR website for details.
