

Fishing Tournament Parking Plan Form

A parking plan is required as part of your tournament application. This plan must demonstrate that tournament participants will not use more than half of the space at state-owned access sites and will not preempt use at public accesses under other ownership. To avoid conflict, you are encouraged to use **no more than half of the parking** at **ANY** public access. If using non-state-owned accesses, you are encouraged to contact the landowner prior to use. Please note that additional off-site parking may be required to accommodate all your tournament participants.

Public access administration, location, and parking capacity can be identified using the Recreation Compass on the DNR website Recreation Compass | Minnesota DNR (state.mn.us). Please note how many rigs will park at each access in the planned tournament use column.

Public Access Location	Landowner	Total Parking	Planned Tournament Use

If your tournament participant numbers exceed half of the available public parking spaces, please describe how parking will be addressed. Examples of alternatives may include parking at private residences, private parking lots with shuttle, street parking (if legal-contact the road authority prior to use) or private business such as a resort or campground with a private ramp.

Additional Parking Plan Details (attach additional pages if necessary): Example: Off-site vehicle/trailer parking will be across the highway from the access on Ms. B's property. Tournament organizers
will help participants cross the highway safely.
