Please Note:

Horse Trail Opens: May 1. Depending on trail conditions, trails may open earlier or later.

Horse Trail Closed: November 1. Trails may close earlier or later than this depending on weather conditions.

Trail Miles: Mileage is only horse trails, they do not include State Forest roads. State forest lands are generally open for outdoor recreation in accordance with state laws.

Nonmotorized trails: Generally open to non-motorized uses, but maybe limited by postings. In the R.J. Dorer State Forest, horses may travel only on designated trails.

Additional Horse Trails: This table includes those areas managed as horse trails within State Forests. Horses are allowed and a horse trail pass is required in other state forest areas not included in this table.
