Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 131 is within Lake and Cook County south of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. DPA 131 has vast amounts of forested public land. Winter severity and habitat have the most impact on the deer population. While large in size, DPA 131 has very low deer densities. Since this is in the primary moose range, the 2022 population goal was to keep the deer population low but stable. However, despite several years of conservative hunting regulations, and very low deer harvests, the deer population continues to decline. Although this past winter was mild for a change, it will take more than one easy winter to increase the deer population. DPA 131 will be Bucks-only again in 2024. No antlerless permits will be offered.
