### Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 155 lies in the southwestern part of Aitkin County and a small portion of southeast Crow Wing and Mille Lacs Counties. It contains a mix of public and private lands. The goal of the DPA is to increase the population 25%. Harvest data, particularly success rates and buck harvest rates, indicate that the goal has not been met. The winter of 2023-24 was quite mild and should help move the population toward goal but there is still a need to be conservative. DPA 155 will remain at Lottery 250 for the 2024 season.
