Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 159 lies in SE Pine County. It is a productive unit for NE MN with a fair amount of farmland. Both the population model and harvest rates indicate a stable to slightly declining deer population over the last 6 years. This past winter DPA 159 went through a new population goal setting exercise. The result of that exercise was a new goal to increase the population by 25%. We also had another tough winter last year that impacted deer survival. The hunting season in 2023 will be conservative in an effort to get the population growing towards the new goal. Antlerless permits will be issued through the Lottery with 500 permits available.
