Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 183 lies in SE Carlton and NE Pine Counties. Both the population model and harvest rates indicate a slightly declining population over the last 6 years. This past winter DPA 183 went through a new population goal setting exercise. The result of that exercise was a new goal to increase the population by 25%. We also had another very tough winter last year that impacted deer survival. The northeast part of this DPA is in the Lake Superior snow belt and was particularly hard hit this past winter. The hunting season in 2023 will be conservative in an effort to get the population growing towards the new goal. Antlerless permits will be issued through the Lottery with 250 permits available.
