Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 214 is very productive, containing little public land, and rarely experiences severe winters. The area covers northeast Todd County, a small amount of southern Wadena, and west-central Morrison Counties. The deer population is approaching goal, and this year's designation of a 3-Deer limit plus Early Antlerless season is meant to provide opportunity to manage deer locally where needed, and to prevent the deer population from increasing far above goal given the extremely mild conditions this past winter.


