Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 219 includes much of western Wright County and the very southeastern portion of Stearns County with a small portion of far eastern Meeker County. Much of this area is interspersed habitats of rolling scattered hardwood forest mixed with agricultural cropland. Two major rivers (North Fork Crow River and Clearwater River) run through this area along with numerous shallow lakes. Deer populations in DPA 219 are currently significantly above goals established in the 2023 public goal setting process. The management designation of a three-deer limit with an early antlerless season is anticipated to stabilize deer populations while providing hunters with tools to manage their local deer herds.
