Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 225 is in the northern portions of Isanti and Chisago Counties along with SE portion of Mille Lacs and southern part of Kanabec and Pine Counties. DPA 225 is still above goal level and growing even though we stepped up management designations with three-deer limit and early antlerless season last year. The recommendation to curb growth and bring the population back down towards goal level, thus a three-deer limit with early antlerless will again be implemented in 2023.

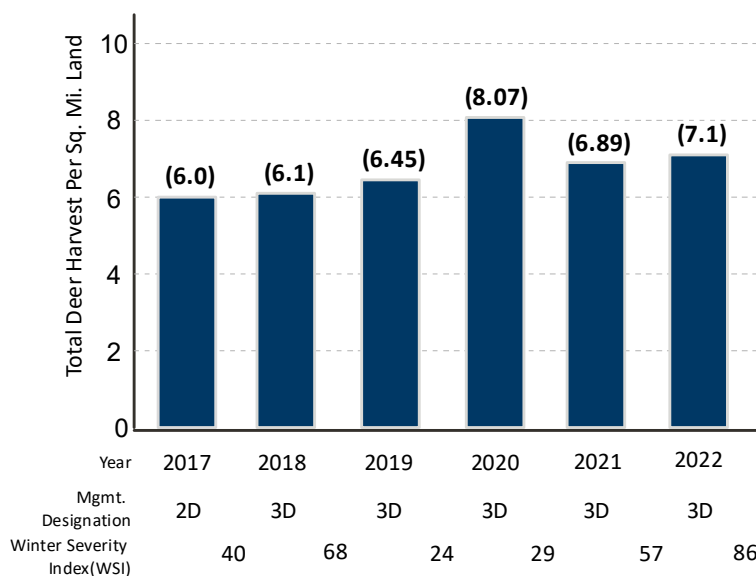

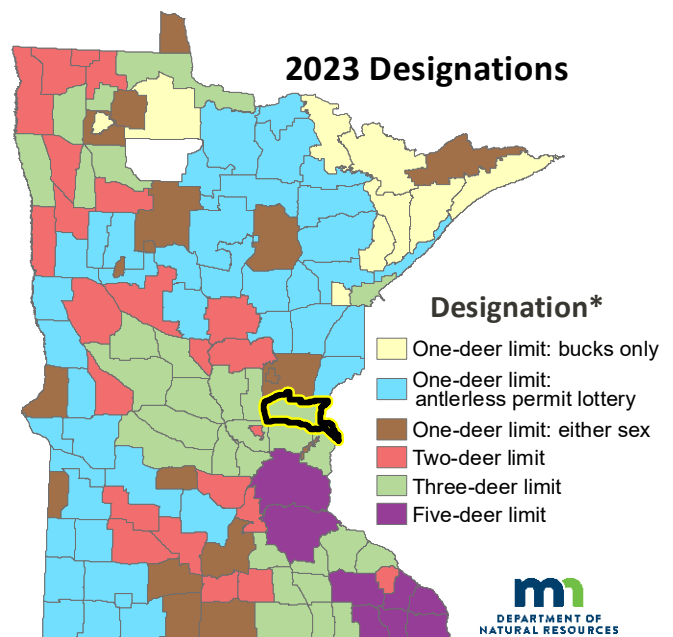
