Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 236 is set within southeast Anoka County, northern Washington County, and southern Chisago County. The southern area is highly developed and borders the metro deer management area (DPA 601) with a five-deer bag limit. DPA 236's population appears to be at the population goal relative to 2022 and we saw harvest rates increase for bucks and antlerless in 2024. Due to a high volume of residential and agricultural conflicts related to deer depredation, another year of Early Antlerless and a 3-Deer limit should help curb the growth rate of this population.

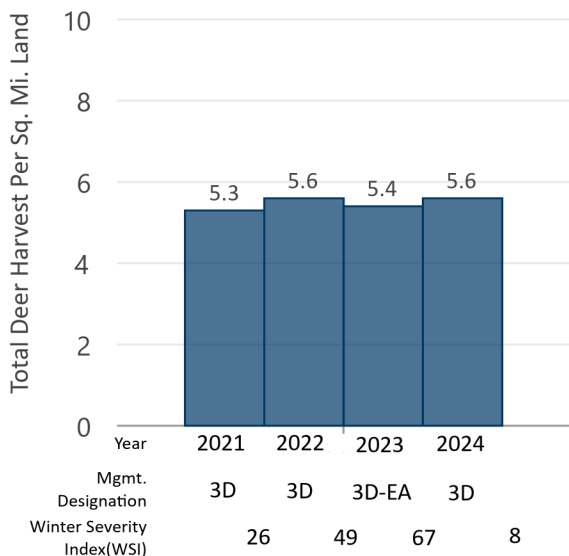
